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Foster Youth Services Coordinating Program (FYSCP)

Foster Youth Services Coordinating Program (FYSCP) provides support services to youth currently in foster care. Services are designed to increase stability of youth in foster care as well as improve educational performance and personal achievement.

FYSCP provides the following services:

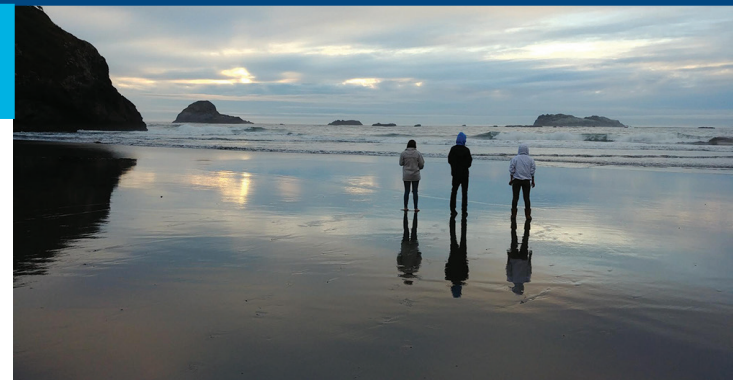
- Support for academic success & tutoring
- Guidance for high school to college transitions
- Advocate for educational rights of youth in foster care
- Professional development on the educational needs of youth in foster care for schools, care providers, child welfare workers and others
- Facilitate communication and collaboration between staff, agencies, child welfare workers/probation officers, care providers & schools
- Immediate and appropriate school placement in coordination with local schools
- AB167 Foster Youth Graduation Exemption eligibility and determination

Independent Living Program (ILP)

Independent Living Program (ILP) assists current and former youth in foster care to reach their independent living goals.

ILP provides the following services:

- Case management
- Workshops including health, housing, social skills, self-advocacy, job skills, budgeting
- Financial incentives for accomplishments such as graduation, employment, setting and keeping goals, etc.
- College field trips and tours
- Fun recreational activities
- Referrals to community resources and connections
- Food pantry



Transitional Housing Program (THP+)

Transitional Housing Program (THP+) assists youth formerly in foster care, ages 18-24, to learn skills to achieve self-sufficiency by providing case management and housing support services.

THP+ provides the following services:

- Financial reimbursements
- Resource referral (employment/education/parenting)
- Housing support services
- Mentor program
- Leadership opportunities

Nevada County Indian Education (NCIE)

Nevada County Indian Education (NCIE) supports schools in meeting the unique educational and cultural needs of native students.

NCIE provides the following services:

- Individual or group tutoring for all grade levels
- Native cultural workshops & events
- Information on local cultural activities & resources
