Rules & Guidelines:

NEW ART INSTALLATION DATES: from MARCH 9TH, 10TH, & 13th, from 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. Please use safety protocols due to COVID-19.

NOTE: Hanging of artwork cannot take place on Tuesdays. Space is available on a first-come basis. No space is reserved. Space is available on wall panels in the upstairs landing and on the walls of the second floor hallways. Have fun!

ENCOURAGED - Signage should name and/or explain the project and include name of teacher, school, and grade. Artists' statements about the work offers greater connection for attendees and of course is a worthy exercise for your students. Thematic and stylistically cohesive displays are preferable. Staples or push pins are recommended to attach art to the walls. Displays should be condensed to as small a space as possible but be well presented.

No more than one piece of art by each student may be displayed. No art may be freestanding on a floor or hanging from the ceiling. Contact Nancy Jackson to discuss any special needs. **Nails and glue are not permitted.** When it is time to remove art, please make sure all staples and push pins have been removed. Thank you!

The exhibition coordinator reserves the right to remove art that does not conform to these guidelines or violates public art display policies of the Nevada County Eric Rood Government Center, a public place of government business. Art depicting nude figures, violence, or obscene language is not permitted.
